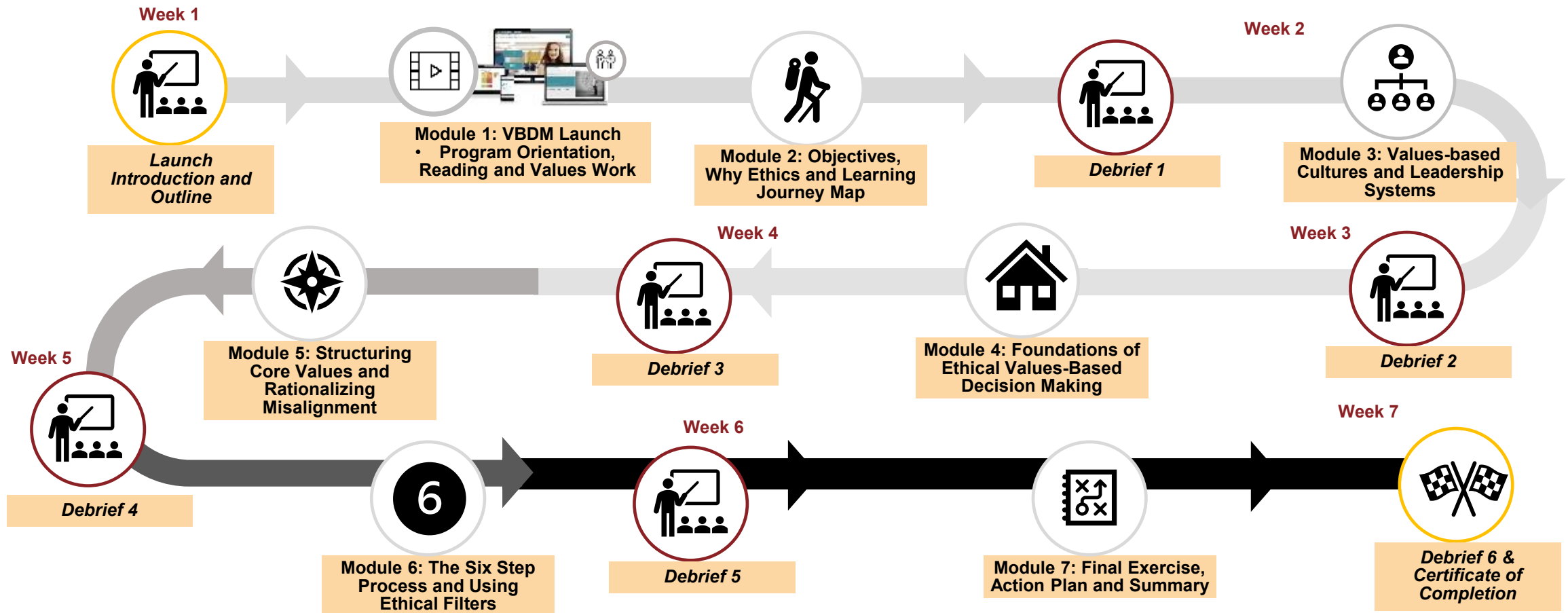

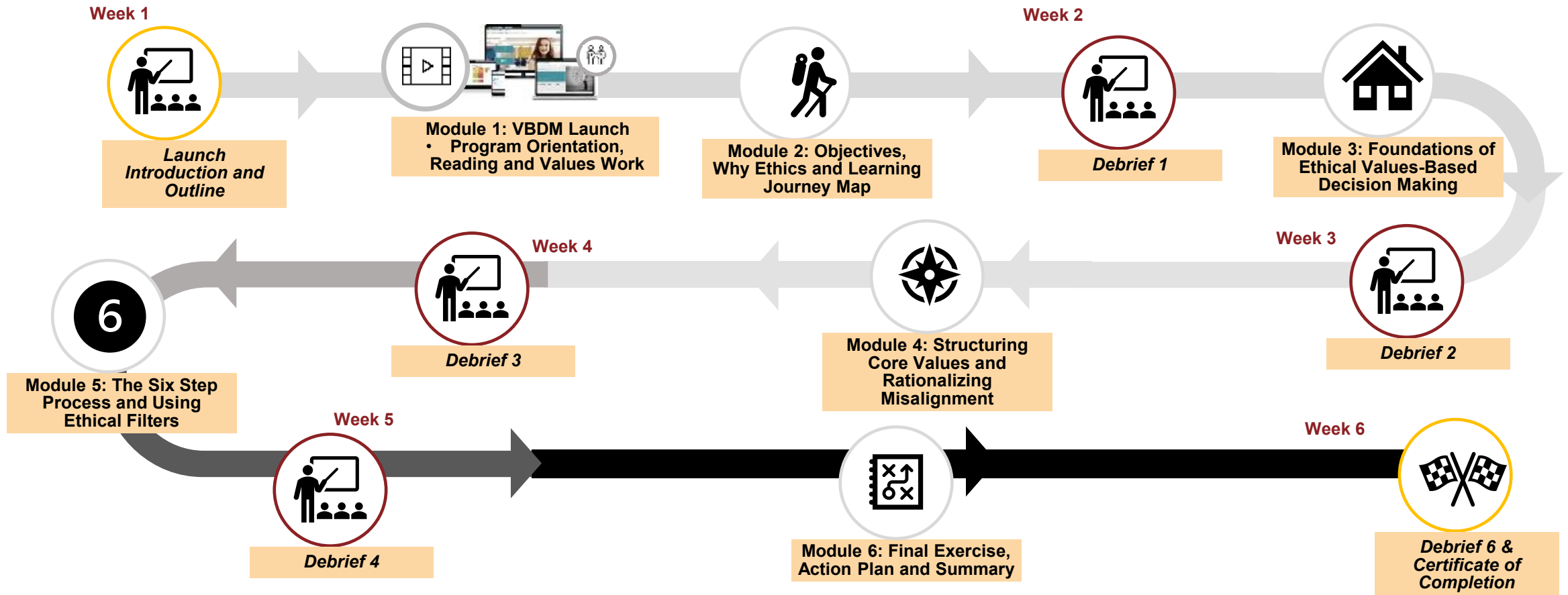


Frontline Associate/Frontline Supervisor

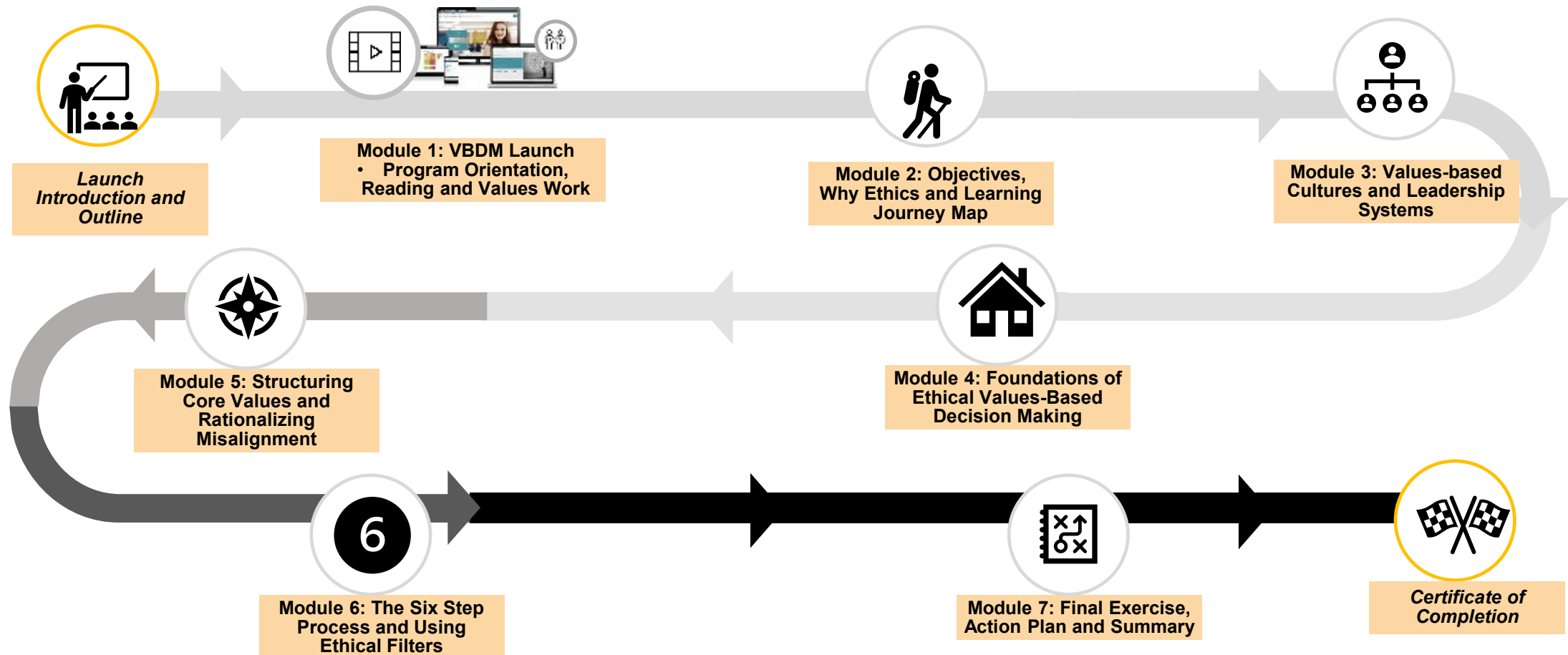


Independent Learner
